

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT – BURN CENTER UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL OF LIEGE

1 Anaesthesiologist with Critical Care certification (H/F)

Part time 50 %

CONTEXT

The burn center of the University Hospital of Liège is one of the 7 centers in Belgium. It is a 6-ICU bed unit where are admitted both adults and children with severe burns or other skin defects.

The burn centered is part of intensive care department in a tertiary teaching hospital, and is in close relationship with the Medical Simulation Center of the Liège University.

With the support of our hospital, the burn center is currently in a new phase of development. The current burn team is composed of an anaesthesiologist with critical care certification, two surgeons (each at part time), a physiotherapist, a psychologist, a dietician and a nursing team.

ROLES

Primary responsibilities for the new colleague include but are not limited to the following:

- Clinical activity: admissions and follow-up of the hospitalized patients, participation to the multidisciplinary care of the burn outpatients, administration of anaesthesia or sedation to patients in the one-day burn clinic.
- On-call activity: participation to the on-call list of the intensive care department
- Supervision of the trainees in anaesthesia and intensive care
- Teaching activities: participation to the lifelong learning program dedicated to the burn team, participation to the teaching of medical students
- Clinical research activities are also possible

QUALIFICATION

- Registration as a specialist in anaesthesiology in Belgium (or equivalent)
- Certification in critical care (or willing to get it)
- Experience in burn care is an advantage (if it's not the case, willing to train)
